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DAY CAMP:

Opens at 9:30 on Monday and 10:00 Tuesday-Friday. CAMP ENDS AT 3:00PM EACH DAY.

Things to bring:

- As there is no charge for children to attend camp we take an offering each day. Give only as you can and the Lord leads.
- swimsuit (one piece for girls, or a t-shirt to cover a two-piece), towel, sunscreen, and a life jacket if you prefer not to use ours.
- Soda money(optional, we do provide drinks at lunch) for sodas at lunch and the end of the day.
- Parental permission slip for 10-12 year olds to take the swim test enabling them to swing off the rope and go to the dock.

Not to bring: Any electronics including cell phones.

Classes are assigned strictly by grade entering in the fall. Twelve year olds who have not attended overnight camp are welcome to attend both day and overnight camp if they have not already attended overnight camp and as room allows.

We do offer baptism, with parental consent for any who have received Jesus as their Savior. On Friday at 3:00 immediately following the Parents program at 2:30.

OVERNIGHT CAMP:

Arrival Time: Between 2 and 4PM Sunday. Departure Time: 12:00 noon Friday. Please be prompt in picking up your teen. Thank you.

What to Bring:

- bedding, including twin mattress cover or fitted sheet
- swimwear(one piece suits for girls or dark colored t-shirt long enough to cover)
- **For Evening Services:** Girls: Slacks, jeans, or skirts(reaching the knee or longer; counselors will decide appropriateness if in question) No shorts. Boys: no caps or shorts. (knee length shorts for girls and guys are acceptable through the day-no short shorts or athletic shorts
- Money for sodas(optional)
- Bibles, pen/pencil, notebook

What not to bring:

- Girls: No halter tops, tank tops with low sides or spaghetti straps; No low cut tops. Boys: must wear shirts at all times, except swimming, and no tank tops with open sides.
- No electronics, radios, tape players, cell phones, etc. that may be lost, broken or stolen. **CELL PHONES BROUGHT TO CAMP MUST BE TURNED IN AT REGISTRATION CHECK IN.**
- If something is needed for specials, it must be kept in the chapel or not brought at all.

Please Note:

- **Campers will be with assigned class/cabin at all times, including swim time and evening services.**
- No one is allowed by the lake after evening services or anytime except during swim time.
- Campers must pass a swim test to go beyond the rope. A lifeguard will be on duty, and buddies will be assigned.
- No bad language or fighting tolerated. No knives, other weapons, drugs, or cigarettes allowed.
- A nurse will be on call and all medications should be turned in to her at registration.
- To leave camp for any reason, you **MUST** have a pass or sign out according to instructions given the day camp starts. Upon returning, turn in your pass and keys. Reasons for leaving and return will be given on Sunday Check in. All cars are to be kept locked from Sunday to Friday and keys turned in to Counselors.
- **CAMP IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST, STOLEN, OR DAMAGED ITEMS**
- **DISCIPLINE AND SPIRITUAL PROBLEMS:** Counselors/Teachers are to be treated with respect. If there are problems they and the director together cannot handle, they will take it to the Board of Directors. It will be at the Board's discretion whether a camper remains or is asked to leave the camp. The camp chaplain, with at least one other adult present, will be available to handle spiritual problems. There is to be at minimum two adults present in disciplining or any other communications with campers.

DOCTRINE: Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, born of a virgin, crucified for our sins, resurrected and sitting at the right hand of God to intercede for us, is the only way of salvation to bring us to the Father. We believe in the Trinity-Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. If campers accept Christ as their savior at camp or prior to, a baptism class is made available and with parental consent, they will have the opportunity to be baptized at 11:30am on Friday.
